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What do we do with your notes?

We write things down about you to help you stay healthy. Sometimes, we show these notes to other doctors or hospital staff, so they know how to take care of you. We will always ask you or your parents before using your notes for science or research.

Is your information safe?

Yes! We follow special laws to make sure what we know about you is kept safe and private

What if you are sick for a long time?

If you have a health problem that doesn't go away quickly, we share your notes with your other doctors so they can all work together to help you feel better.

Can you stop us from sharing?

Yes. If you don't want us to share your notes, your parents or the adults looking after you can tell us

Can you see your notes?

Yes! You have the right to see what we have written. Your parents can ask us to show them to you.

What if you have a question?

If you are worried or have a question, just ask your doctor, a nurse, or your parents. We are here to help!
